- Despite high cure rates, childhood cancer still kills more children in the world than any other disease
- An estimated 1,400 children lose their battle with cancer every year

Know the Main Signs and Symptoms of Childhood Cancers



Continued, unexplained weight loss. Constant infections or recurrent persistent fevers of unknown origin

Headaches, often with early morning vomiting. Increased swelling or persistent pain in bones, joints, back or legs. Lump or mass especially in the abdomen, neck, chest, pelvis or armpits

A whitish colour behind the pupils

Non traumatic bruises

Constant tiredness or noticeable paleness

Eye or vision changes which occur suddenly or persist
